**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING DELTA COUNTY HISTORIC LANDMARK BOARD AND
PROCEDURES FOR HISTORIC LANDMARK DESIGNATION**

WHEREAS, Colorado Revised Statutes, § 30-11-107(bb), empowers the Board of County Commissioners of Delta County to provide for the preservation of the cultural, historic and architectural history within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners desires to establish a procedure for the designation of the appropriate historic sites as Historic Landmarks, recognizing such a designation to be an integral part of the awareness and preservation of cultural, historic and architectural history within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners believe it would be to the benefit of the general welfare of the citizens of Delta County to establish a historic landmark board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Delta County that

The Board adopts the following procedures as the means and method for designating a "Delta County Historic Landmark":

- A. The Delta County Historical Landmark Board (DCHLB), a volunteer citizen committee, is hereby created. This board will represent all of Delta County and operate pursuant to its own By-Laws and Operational Guidelines.
- B. The DCHLB is authorized and directed to act as a body for the purpose of making recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners regarding the official designation of cultural, historic and architectural historical sites within the County.
- C. The procedure for requesting and recognizing Historic Landmark designation, along with the forms and documentation requirements for such designation, shall be determined by the DCHLB in its adopted Operational Guidelines.
- D. Any person or entity seeking Historic Landmark designation for any property, feature or structure within the boundaries of Delta County shall submit a signed copy of the requested documentation to the DCHLB, which shall then forward a recommendation to the Board of County Commissioners.

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- E. The Board of County Commissioners shall not designate any individual structure or site without the written consent of the owners of the structure or site.
- F. Upon receipt of a recommendation from the DCHLB, the Board of County Commissioners shall within thirty (30) days at a regularly scheduled meeting, hold a public hearing on the designation application. The Board of County Commissioners shall then make a determination regarding the request for historic designation. Should such determination be in favor of historic designation, the Board of County Commissioners shall officially proclaim the designation by means of a County resolution, which shall be documented in the official meeting minutes.
- G. The Board of County Commissioners shall establish the Delta County Historic Register, containing copies of all successful submissions for listing, which shall be physically located in the office of the County Clerk and Recorder, in a file titled "Delta County Historic Landmark Register." The County shall also post and periodically update the list of DCHLB board members, contact information, forms and the cumulative landmark register on the County's website, subject to the owner's approval at time of the application.
