**Delta, Colorado, June 15, 2020 – Delta County Daily Update**

**UPDATED Testing Information:** Delta County Health Department is reporting two new cases; our total case count is 78 with 67 individuals now recovered.

- 77: Female, in her 60s, self-isolating at home
- 78: Male, in his 60s, self-isolating at home

48 individuals have tested positive; 30 individuals have been in close contact with an individual who tested positive, and have experienced COVID-19 symptoms; one death is being reported.

To date, 1,680 tests have been administered in Delta County; 45 tests are pending.

Delta County wants to remind everyone of your personal responsibility in keeping our curve flattened; please do you your part in:

- Maintaining 6 feet of physical distance from others
- Wash your hands often
- Cover your face in public
- Stay home if you are at risk or sick
- Self-report and call in immediately if you are sick

**State Update**

In Governor Polis' press conference today he talked about more "opening" up of Colorado for residential camps, indoor events, as well as outdoor events. Once again, Coloradans are asked to submit feedback on the three areas via a specific feedback form; **please do not** call the Delta County Health Department to provide feedback.
