Delta, Colorado, June 26, 2020 – Delta County Daily Update

UPDATED Testing Information: Delta County Health Department is reporting two new cases; our total case remains at 82 with 76 individuals recovered.

- #81 – Male, in his 20s, case investigation is underway
- #82 – Male, in his 30s, self-isolating at home

52 individuals have tested positive; 30 individuals have been in close contact with an individual who tested positive, and have experienced COVID-19 symptoms; one death is being reported.

Delta County Update

Delta County continues to await Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment's (CDPHE) response to the 2nd variance request that was submitted on Monday, June 8.

Governor Polis and CDPHE will roll out a new phase, "Protect Your Neighbor" in early July. Counties will have to be approved to move into one of the levels of "Protect Your Neighbor"; additional information will be available next week.

The Delta Volunteer Fire Department will shoot their annual Firework show the evening of Saturday, July 4. As in years past, the show will take place over Confluence Lake, however, Confluence Park will be closed to vehicles and pedestrians; individuals are encouraged to watch the fireworks show from their homes. Due to the COVID pandemic, the Delta Volunteer Fire Department was unable to do the type of fundraising necessary to replenish their funds for next year's show.
