Delta, Colorado, July 17, 2020 – Delta County Daily Update

UPDATED Testing Information:

Delta County Health Department is reporting that our total case count remains at 86 with 83 individuals recovered. 56 individuals have tested positive; 30 individuals have been in close contact with an individual who tested positive, and have experienced COVID-19 symptoms; one death is being reported.

To date, 3,074 tests have been administered; 157 are pending.

Delta County Update:

Delta County remains in the Safer at Home and in the Vast, Great Outdoors phase; we have not applied for, or moved into the Protect Your Neighbor phase. As a reminder, here are some of the parameters of our current phase:

- Confined indoor space: 50% of posted occupancy, ensuring 28 square feet distancing, up to 175 individuals
- Outdoor space: up to 250 individuals
- Delta County Public Libraries may reopen at 50% capacity or 50 people per building; whichever is less
- Delta County Museums may reopen at 50% capacity or 50 people per building; whichever is less
- Competitive events permitted up to 50 people gathered
- Youth/Adult sports up to 50 individuals outdoors or 10 indoors
- Trails and Conservation crews up to 25 people

In yesterday's press conference, Governor Polis stated that all variance requests are on hold for at least two weeks.
