ORDER OF THE SHERIFF – 2022-01

STAGE 1 FIRE RESTRICTIONS RESCINDED FOR UNINCORPORATED DELTA COUNTY

- EFFECTIVE WEDNESDAY, JUNE 29, 2022 at 12:01 a.m. -

WHEREAS, the Delta County Sheriff, pursuant to § 30-10-512 C.R.S and § 30-10-513 C.R.S is authorized to serve as the fire warden of Delta County and pursuant to Delta County Resolution 2022-R-019, the Sheriff was authorized by the Delta County Board of County Commissioners to enact or rescind fire restrictions in unincorporated Delta County;

WHEREAS, the Sheriff in coordination with local, state and federal land management agencies, emergency management and fire suppression agencies has determined the current danger of forest or grass fires in unincorporated Delta County has reduced due to recent monsoon moisture to the region; and;

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of fire suppression and land management officials to lift Stage 1 restrictions within Bureau of Land Management Lands and the GMUG National Forest lands within Delta County; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff finds Stage 1 Fire Restrictions are no longer necessary or in the best interests of the citizens and residents of Delta County;

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered that as of June 29, 2022 at 12:01 a.m., all stage 1 fire restrictions implemented by Delta County Resolution 2022-R-018 on June 15, 2022 are hereby rescinded until such time or conditions warrant restrictions being re-implemented.
